
We are planning 4 sessions at this time with 3 additional dates to be announced later.

Are you curious about the largest land war in Europe since World War II? Join us for a discussion of the war from various angles:


- How did this war start?

Children's Sunday School Classes will meet through the month of June from 9:45am to 10:45am in the Education Building, 3rd floor classrooms.


