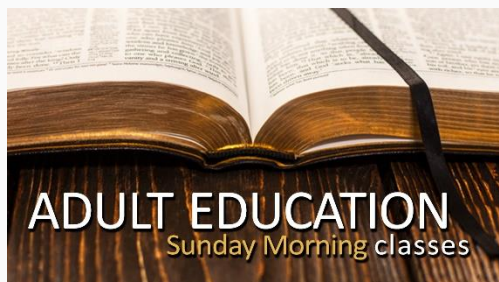

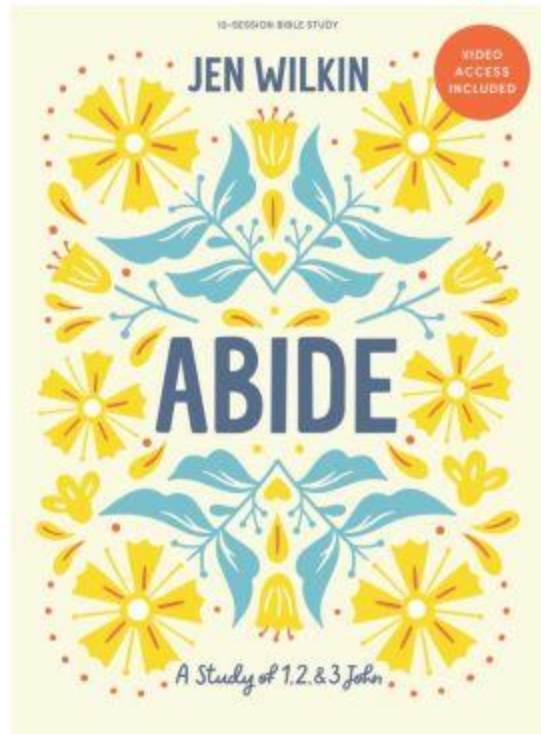

Explorers Class

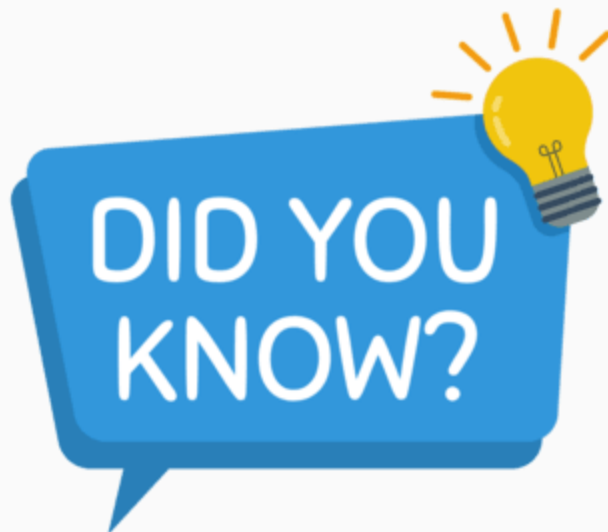
This Sunday we will use a drop in study titled "**How Spirituality Develops Through Our Lifetime - Maturing in the Christian life of body, mind and spirit.**"
