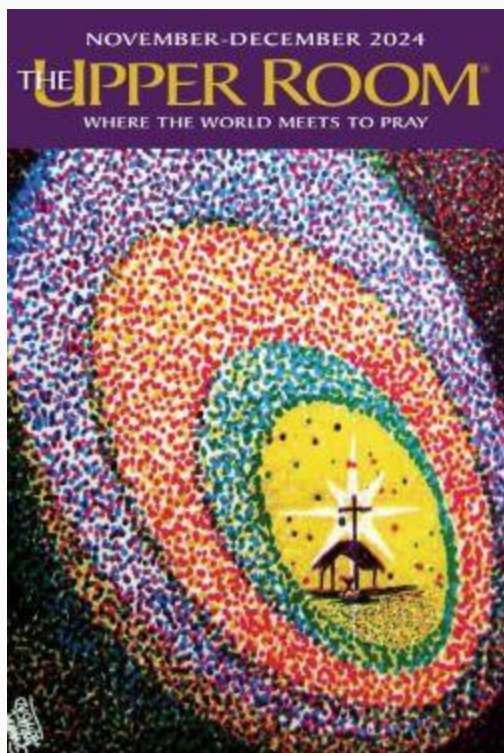

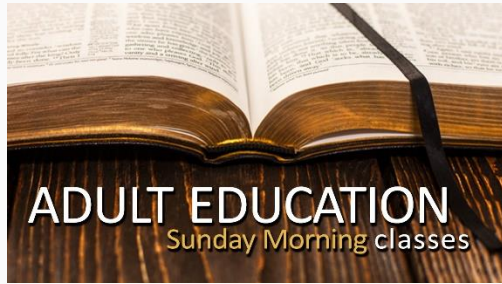

The entire Weaverville community and beyond is invited to gather in prayer.



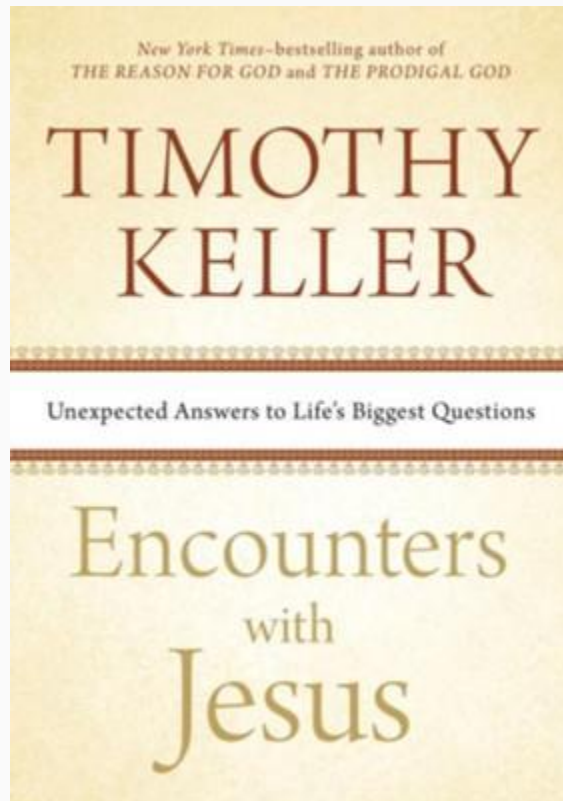
WUMC Prayer Meeting
