
who passed into God's kingdom on October 3, 2024. She was a longtime member at Weaverville United Methodist Church.



Each Wednesday morning from 8 AM-9 AM in the Education Building, or join us in spirit.


The class meets every Sunday in the Education Building, main floor at 10 am. The current study is "*Encounters with Jesus*" by Timothy Keller

Women's Bible Study


