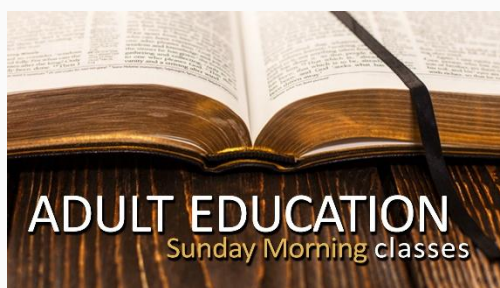


Join us for our next sewing bee!

Explorers Class

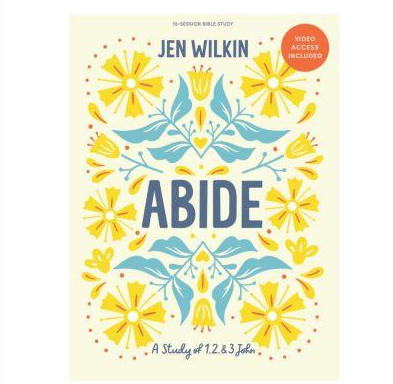
The class meets every Sunday in the Education Building, main floor at 10 am. Beginning on Sunday, January 26, we will start Everything Must Change by Brian McLaren.
