




M&M Luncheon Thursday, April 17

Remember that being Methodist or mature or not requirements for attending, and friends are always welcome!






Sunday School meets Sunday mornings at 9:45am upstairs in the Education Building.

The class meets every Sunday in the Education Building, main floor at 10 am. The current study is *Everything Must Change* by Brian McLaren.




Women's Bible Study


